When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to him and said, “I am El-Shaddai—‘God Almighty.’ Serve me faithfully and live a blameless life. <sup>2</sup> I will make a covenant with you, by which I will guarantee to give you countless descendants.”

<sup>3</sup> At this, Abram fell face down on the ground. Then God said to him, <sup>4</sup> “This is my covenant with you: I will make you the father of a multitude of nations! <sup>5</sup> What’s more, I am changing your name. It will no longer be Abram. **EPISTLE READING** Romans 5:1-11 (*We were reconciled to Him.*)

Elder: <sup>1</sup> Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>2</sup> through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God. <sup>3</sup> Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; <sup>4</sup> perseverance, character; and character, hope. <sup>5</sup> And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.

## Children's Message – Be a Filter!

**HOLY GOSPEL** *Mark 8:27–38* (“Take up your cross and follow Me.”)

Elder: Then Jesus began to tell them that the Son of Man must suffer many terrible things and be rejected by the elders, the leading priests, and the teachers of religious law. He would be killed, but three days later he would rise from the dead. As he talked about this openly with his disciples, Peter took him aside and began to reprimand him for saying such things.

Jesus turned around and looked at his disciples, then reprimanded Peter. “Get away from me, Satan!” he said. “You are seeing things merely from a human point of view, not from God’s.”

**People: Then, calling the crowd to join his disciples, he said, “If any of you wants to be my follower, you must turn from your selfish ways, take up your cross, and follow me.**

Elder: If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for my sake and for the sake of the Good News, you will save it.

**People: And what do you benefit if you gain the whole world but lose your own soul? Is anything worth more than your soul?**

Elder: If anyone is ashamed of me and my message in these adulterous and sinful days, the Son of Man will be ashamed of that person when he returns in the glory of his Father with the holy angels.”

Guatemala Update- Change of Plans- Until this past week the St. Paul mission team had been making plans to go to the village of Tasharte in Guatemala, but it turns out that God has other plans for us. Due family medical issues, the coordinator of mission teams has been unable to arrange for transportation, meals, lodging, etc. in Tasharte. Since Tasharte is in a remote location which has not had a mission team in over 4 years, and due to the short time before departure, MOST has decided to move us to a different location in Guatemala.

The new destination for the St. Paul mission team is the Santa Cruz church which is on the shores of Lake Amatitlan, about an hour outside of Guatemala City. Our health and hygiene education and construction missions remain the same however, and the flight arrangements will be the same. There is an active children's ministry at the Santa Cruz church which will benefit from the health and hygiene education, and the church also has need of refurbishing which will keep the construction crew busy.

One of the first things any mission goer learns is the importance of staying flexible. The Saint Paul mission team is committed to going where God sends us and serving in whatever capacity God desires for us. We are deeply grateful for the prayers and support we have received from the St. Paul community and will keep you informed as our departure date approaches.
