

A Community of Rebels

AS WE GATHER

Our culture is fascinated with rebels. Characters such as Han Solo, Ferris Bueller, and Katniss Everdeen are not perfect, but we admire how they stand up to authority. Whether being a rebel is good or bad depends on whom one is rebelling against. When the authority is God Almighty, rebels are not looked upon so fondly. Israel rebelled against God, and Ezekiel told them just that. The people of Nazareth rejected Jesus, rebelling against their own hometown prophet. Paul was a rebel himself, first against the followers of Jesus, and then on their behalf. Sin is rebellion against God. Yet God forgives our rebellion through Jesus' death and resurrection, turning our rebellion into reconciliation and rejoicing. Despite our weaknesses and inclination to rebel, God's grace comes to us in Jesus, and He is sufficient for us.



EPISTLE 2 Corinthians 12:7-10

(We rejoice in our weaknesses because they showcase the power, mercy, and grace of Christ.)

Paul's Thorn in the Flesh

Reader: ⁷ So to keep me from becoming conceited because of the surpassing greatness of the revelations, a thorn was given me in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to harass me, to keep me from becoming conceited.
⁸ Three times I pleaded with the Lord about this, that it should leave me.

People: ⁹ But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."

HOLY GOSPEL *Mark 6:1–13*

(Jesus is rejected in His hometown but sends out the Twelve disciples to proclaim repentance, cast out demons, and heal the sick.)

Reader: The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark, the sixth chapter.

People: Glory to You, O Lord.

Jesus Rejected at Nazareth

Reader: **6** He went away from there and came to his hometown, and his disciples followed him. **2** And on the Sabbath he began to teach in the synagogue, and many who heard him were astonished, saying, "Where did this man get these things? What is the wisdom given to him? How are such mighty works done by his hands? **3** Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary and brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon? And are not his sisters here with us?" And they took offense at him.

People: ⁴ **And Jesus said to them, “A prophet is not without honor, except in his hometown and among his relatives and in his own household.”**

Reader: ⁵ And he could do no mighty work there, except that he laid his hands on a few sick people and healed them. ⁶ And he marveled because of their unbelief. And he went about among the villages teaching.

Jesus Sends Out the Twelve Apostles

Reader: ⁷ And he called the twelve and began to send them out two by two, and gave them authority over the unclean spirits. ⁸ He charged them to take nothing for their journey except a staff—no bread, no bag, no money in their belts— ⁹ but to wear sandals and not put on two tunics.

People: ¹⁰ **And he said to them, “Whenever you enter a house, stay there until you depart from there. ¹¹ And if any place will not receive you and they will not listen to you, when you leave, shake off the dust that is on your feet as a testimony against them.”**

Reader: ¹² So they went out and proclaimed that people should repent. ¹³ And they cast out many demons and anointed with oil many who were sick and healed them.

Reader: This is the Gospel of the Lord.

People: Praise to You, O Christ.

Devotion

Bible references: Judges 2:6-23 & Psalm 2:1-8

But whenever the judge died, they turned back and were more corrupt than their fathers, going after other gods, serving them and bowing down to them. *Judges 2:19*

When You Turn Your Back

Pastor: The summary of God’s people’s actions in Judges 2 is morbidly bleak. After all of God’s mighty deliverances of His people, from slavery and starvation and homelessness, they rejected Him and turned to other gods. “They did not drop any of their practices or stubborn ways” (v19). In His wrath, God turned them over to their enemies, to plunderers, warriors, and enslavers.

Elder: As Solomon wrote of human life and work in Ecclesiastes, “There is nothing new under the sun” (1:9). We, too, have been blessed beyond measure by God’s good grace and favor. We, too, turn our back on God, chasing other gods, from material ones to spiritual ones, mesmerized by glowing screens and our own selfish, sin-black desires.

Pastor: Yet God never fails to call us to repentance. He continues to show forth His love and mercy to us. When we turn our back on God, He remains, strong and able to save us. In the face of our sin and rejection, He is faithful. How great is our Redeemer, who loves us constantly.

***O Christ, continue Your new and merciful work in redeeming us, despite our idolatry.
Bless us to receive Your mercies. Amen.***






