## PRAYER OF THE DAY

**Pastor:** Almighty God, You are the unseen presence in all human affairs, the unseen actor in the drama of our lives. Though our days are now marked by sorrow, in a little while we will see Jesus. Grant us Your Spirit that we may behold You through eyes of faith as You come among us by Your Word and Sacraments; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever..

**People:** **Amen.**

**FIRST READING** *Acts 11:1–18* (The Gentiles have received God’s Word.)

**Reader:** Soon the news reached the apostles and other believers in Judea that the Gentiles had received the word of God. <sup>2</sup> But when Peter arrived back in Jerusalem, the Jewish believers<sup>1</sup> criticized him.

**People:** <sup>3</sup> **“You entered the home of Gentiles and even ate with them!” they said.**

**Reader:** <sup>4</sup> Then Peter told them exactly what had happened. <sup>5</sup> “I was in the town of Joppa,” he said, “and while I was praying, I went into a trance and saw a vision. Something like a large sheet was let down by its four corners from the sky. And it came right down to me. <sup>6</sup> When I looked inside the sheet, I saw all sorts of tame and wild animals, reptiles, and birds. <sup>7</sup> And I heard a voice say, ‘Get up, Peter; kill and eat them.’

**People:** <sup>8</sup> **“‘No, Lord,’ I replied. ‘I have never eaten anything that our Jewish laws have declared impure or unclean.’**

Reader: <sup>9</sup> "But the voice from heaven spoke again: 'Do not call something unclean if God has made it clean.' <sup>10</sup> This happened three times before the sheet and all it contained was pulled back up to heaven.

<sup>11</sup> "Just then three men who had been sent from Caesarea arrived at the house where we were staying. <sup>12</sup> The Holy Spirit told me to go with them and not to worry that they were Gentiles. These six brothers here accompanied me, and we soon entered the home of the man who had sent for us. <sup>13</sup> He told us how an angel had appeared to him in his home and had told him, 'Send messengers to Joppa, and summon a man named Simon Peter. <sup>14</sup> He will tell you how you and everyone in your household can be saved!'

**People:** <sup>15</sup> **"As I began to speak," Peter continued, "the Holy Spirit fell on them, just as he fell on us at the beginning. <sup>16</sup> Then I thought of the Lord's words when he said, 'John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.' <sup>17</sup> And since God gave these Gentiles the same gift he gave us when we believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I to stand in God's way?"**

Reader: <sup>18</sup> When the others heard this, they stopped objecting and began praising God. They said, "We can see that God has also given the Gentiles the privilege of repenting of their sins and receiving eternal life."

Reader: This is the Word of the Lord.

**People: Thanks be to God!**

**SECOND READING**     *Revelation 21:1–7*     (God dwells with people.)

Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. <sup>2</sup> And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. <sup>3</sup> And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. <sup>4</sup> He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away."

<sup>5</sup> And he who was seated on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." Also he said, "Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true." <sup>6</sup> And he said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. He will tell you about the future. <sup>14</sup> He will bring me glory by telling you whatever he receives from me. <sup>15</sup> All that belongs to the Father is mine; this is why I said, 'The Spirit will tell you whatever he receives from me.'

<sup>16</sup> "In a little while you won't see me anymore. But a little while after that, you will see me again."

<sup>17</sup> Some of the disciples asked each other, "What does he mean when he says, 'In a little while you won't see me, but then you will see me,' and 'I am going to the Father'?" <sup>18</sup> And what does he mean by 'a little while'? We don't understand."

<sup>19</sup> Jesus realized they wanted to ask him about it, so he said, "Are you asking yourselves what I meant? I said in a little while you won't see me, but a little while after that you will see me again. <sup>20</sup> I tell you the truth, you will weep and mourn over what is going to happen to me, but the world will rejoice. You will grieve, but your grief will suddenly turn to wonderful joy. <sup>21</sup> It will be like a woman suffering the pains of labor. When her child is born, her anguish gives way to joy because she has brought a new baby into the world. <sup>22</sup> So you have sorrow now, but I will see you again; then you will rejoice, and no one can rob you of that joy.

Reader: This is the Gospel of the Lord.

**People: Praise to You, O Christ.**

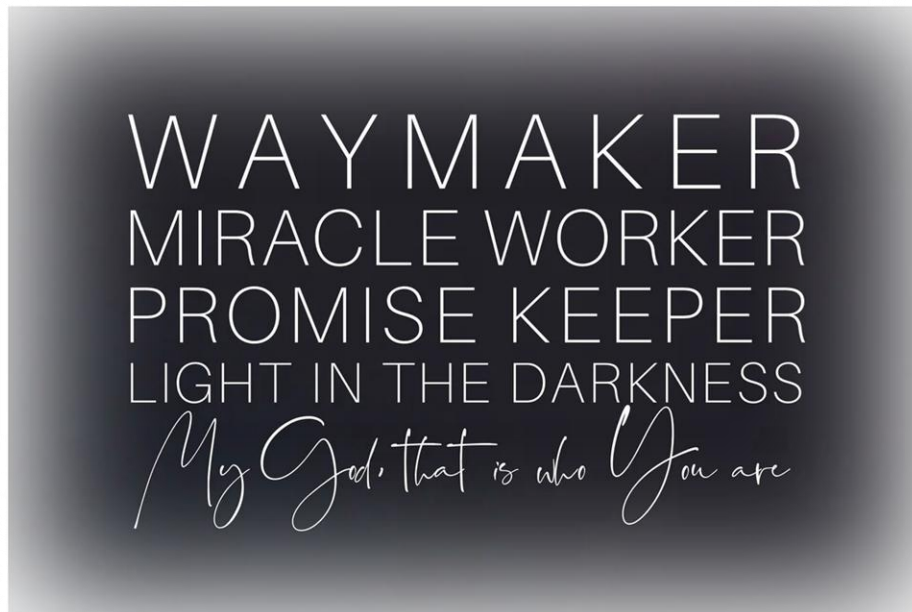

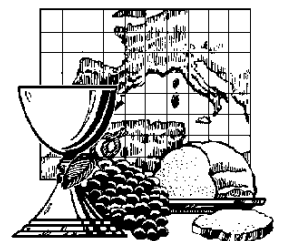

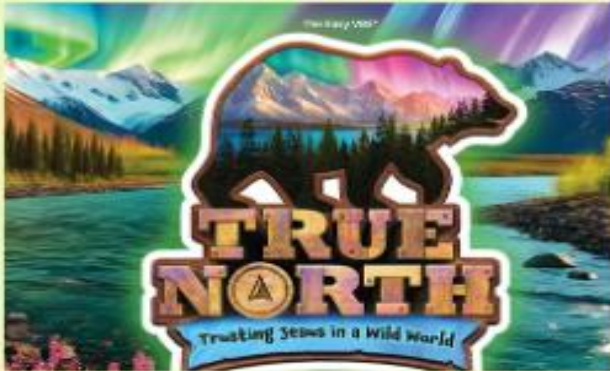


For the month of May, Women in Christ is honoring the LWML Mission Grant entitled New Shepherds for South Sudan (Lutheran Heritage Foundation) for \$18,000. The people of South Sudan are in need of the gospel, living in extreme poverty, civil war, famine, and disease, with average life expectancy of only 56 years. The Evangelical Lutheran Church in South Sudan (ELCSS) has more than 200 congregations, but fewer than 80 pastors to serve them. Need for new pastors is great, as each pastor is responsible for preaching God's word to at least three congregations, often long distances apart. Lutheran Heritage Foundation in Macomb, MI, has partnered with ELCSS to establish a seminary, the Concordia Lutheran Institute for the Holy Ministry (CLIHM) to provide theological education for new pastors. These CLIHM seminarians come from extreme poverty and do not have funds to cover educational costs. This grant would support five South Sudan seminarians for one year, providing tuition, supplies, room and board. Please consider this great need when you fill your MITE box this month.
