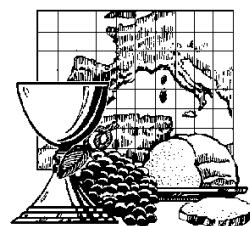

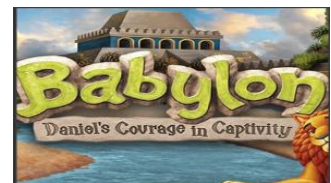

They have been steadfast servants sharing their time and talents with our children. We thank Jake Fairbairn, Kara Patterson, Jennifer Huggins and Mark Ernst for helping out from time to time. All of these volunteers will be recognized by the Board of Youth and Family Education on June 4, 2023 during coffee hour. We hope that you can attend to help celebrate another successful year of Sunday school.

**Speaking of Sunday school,** we are in need of volunteers for next year. To operate a meaningful Sunday school program we must divide the 4-11 year old children into two groups. Now that more children are attending it is apparent that each group (younger/older) requires their own set of lessons and activities. Kristen Goodman has graciously agreed to teach the older group. We need someone to teach the younger group. We are seeking one volunteer who can commit to most Sunday mornings, starting Sept. 17, 10:00-10:45, to teach a Bible lesson to the younger group. Lessons and supplies will be provided to the volunteer. Two people might consider sharing the role. However, we need consistency so that our children can receive meaningful weekly instruction.
