Epistle *Ephesians 6:10-20* (God provides all the spiritual armor we need to withstand assaults from all sides.)

¹⁰ Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹ Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. ¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. ¹³ Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. ¹⁴ Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, ¹⁵ and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. ¹⁶ In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. ¹⁷ Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. ¹⁸ And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people. ¹⁹ Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, ²⁰ for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should.

Old Testament *Deuteronomy 4:1–2, 6–9* **Moses Urges Israel to Obey**

Reader: “And now, Israel, listen carefully to these decrees and regulations that I am about to teach you. Obey them so that you may live, so you may enter and occupy the land that the Lord, the God of your ancestors, is giving you.
² Do not add to or subtract from these commands I am giving you. Just obey the commands of the Lord your God that I am giving you.
⁶ Obey them completely, and you will display your wisdom and intelligence among the surrounding nations. When they hear all these decrees, they will exclaim, ‘How wise and prudent are the people of this great nation!’ ⁷ For what great nation has a god as near to them as the Lord our God is near to us whenever we call on him? ⁸ And what great nation has decrees and regulations as righteous and fair as this body of instructions that I am giving you today?

*Stand***Holy Gospel** Mark 7:14-23*(The sin under our skin is the source of evil thoughts, words, and deeds.)*

Reader: ¹⁴ Again Jesus called the crowd to him and said, "Listen to me, everyone, and understand this.

Maybury State Park main entrance is located on 8 mile, west of Beck. There is a \$9 entry fee if you do not have a license plate pass that you purchased along with your license plate renewal. After parking it is a short walk on pavement to the Oak Shelter. There will be signs (and people) to help guide your way. There are restrooms located at the site. Following the service there will be games for the children (and adults) and a potluck lunch. Beverages will be provided. There are picnic tables for lunch located in a covered pavilion.
